Discussion was had on the rest area and Cornerstone Ministries Church garbage pick up. The Town will continue to pick garbage up since they are paying utilities services. Services are exchanged with the state department for garbage services. Beginning September 15, the Town will not accept contractors bringing in loads. Discussion was had on the reduced hours and limited days for the landfill. PW Director stated he was looking at the landfill being open from 10-5 on Thursday and Friday and from 8-1 every other Saturday. Garbage cans will need to be locked at the parks, rest areas and those that could be possibly used once services are ceased for out of town garbage. Discussion was had on the yard waste and a possible localized spot to set up. Clerk Schneider discussed the significant decrease in revenue and how that will affect the budget. She asked to look at the budget to see what could be cut because of the shortfall. In addition, all residents should have a garbage charge. The public works department will provide the clerk's office with the garbage can assignments for review. The guys can do it while they are doing their meter reads. In addition, every trailer park and apartment should pay a garbage rate. Discussion was had on the land at the landfill and permitting.

Discussion was also had on the continued sewer problems on Powder River. Heath provided costs for the sanitary sewer improvements and water improvement project. It would cost \$4 million for both water and sewer projects. Councilman Mathews asked PW Allison to schedule a camera right away to see if it is tree branches and if it something that can be delayed. Heath stated the Emergency Applications are due Sept. 21st for the October 5th SLIB meeting and September 21st for the June 18th SLIB meeting. The costs of the camera can come out of the 3rd specific fund. Heath will recap this information at Monday's council meeting.
