Regular Meeting of the Council
Monday, May 24, 2021

Town Council Present: Mayor Dick Claar, Councilmen Ben Glenn, Dale Petersen, Austin Smith and Paul Smoot.

Town Representatives Present: Deputy Clerk- Jodi Clark, Police Chief- Bill Bryant and HDR Engineer- Heath Turbiville

Mayor Claar called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm with the Pledge of Allegiance being said.

Guest:

Dorothy Baron was present to discuss the Carr Road condition.

Councilman Smith motioned with Councilman Glenn 2nd to approve the Consent Agenda leaving Bill List #3 out. Motioned carried. 4/0

Councilman Petersen motioned to approve Bill List #3 with Councilman Smoot 2nd. Motion carried. 4/0. Councilman Glenn abstained due to conflict of interest.

Clerk's Report:

Deputy Clerk Clark read the Clerk's Report.

A Minor Subdivision Plat was presented for approval. **Councilman Petersen motioned to approve the 11.59 acre Plat of the Minor Subdivision, Councilman Smith 2nd. Motion carried. 4/0**

Councilman Glenn motioned to allow Pinnacle Bank to use the Town Facility as a place to setup business if needed in a disaster situation. Councilman Smoot 2nd. Motion carried. 4/0

Councilman Petersen motioned to apply for the application for the Landfill with the USDA. Councilman Glenn 2nd. Motion carried. 4/0

Deputy Clerk Clark read the ordinance for the budget. **Councilman Glenn motioned to approve the 2nd reading of Ordinance No. 1-2021 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING MONEY FOR THE 12 MONTH PERIOD BEGINNING JULY 1, 2021 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2022. Councilman Smith 2nd. Motion carried. 4/0**

Budget Meeting was set for June 7th at 4:00 in the Chambers.

Public Works Report:

Mayor Claar stated the Public Works Director Allison is interested in purchasing a pickup. **Councilman Glenn motioned to allow the advertising of bids for a pickup for the Public Works. Councilman Petersen 2nd. Motion carried. Councilmen Glenn, Petersen & Smith –Ayes. Councilman Smoot-Nay. Motion carried. 3/1**

Mayor Claar brought up that the Public Works would like to get bids on contracting the mowing at the Cemetery. **Councilman Petersen motioned to advertise to accept contractor's bids to mow the Cemetery twice a month with everything in the fence maintained for the months of June – September. Councilman Smith 2nd. Motion carried. 4/0**

Police Report:

Chief Bryant gave the Police Report.

Councilman Glenn motioned and Councilman Smith 2nd to approve the reading of Ordinance No 2-2021 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND RESTATING IN ITS ENTIRETY AND ADOPTING A NUISANCE COMPLIANCE PROGRAM. Motion carried. 4/0

Councilman Petersen motioned to go into Executive Session at 7:34 to discuss land acquisition and personnel Councilman Glenn 2nd. Motion carried 4/0. Council reconvened at 8:40. Councilman Petersen motioned to advertise for sealed bids for Lot 3, North One-Half (N1/2) of Lot 4, South 25 feet of Lot 4 (being the S1/2 of Lot 4), Block 3, First Addition to the Town of Moorcroft, Crook County, Wyoming with a minimum of \$75,000. The sealed bids will be accepted at Town of Moorcroft, PO Box 70 or 104 N Big Horn, Moorcroft WY 82721, no later than 5:00p.m. on June 28th, 2021. The bids will be opened at the Council Meeting on June 28th at 7:05p.m., Councilman Glenn 2nd, Motion carried. 4/0
