Resolution # 4-2024

Adopting the 2024 Wyoming Region 1 Hazard Mitigation Plan

Whereas, the Town of Moorcroft recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within our community; and

Whereas, undertaking hazard mitigation actions will reduce the potential for harm to people and property from future hazard occurrences; and

Whereas, an adopted Hazard Mitigation Plan is required as a condition of future funding for mitigation projects under multiple FEMA pre- and post-disaster mitigation grant programs; and

Whereas, the Town of Moorcroft resides within the Planning Area, and fully participated in the mitigation planning process to prepare this Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

Now, therefore, be it resolved, that the Town of Moorcroft, hereby adopts the Wyoming Region 1 Hazard Mitigation Plan, as an official plan; and

Be it further resolved, the Town of Moorcroft will submit this Adoption Resolution to the Wyoming Office of Homeland Security and Federal Emergency Management Agency, Region VIII officials to enable the Plan's final approval. Subsequent plan updates following the approval period for this plan will require separate adoption resolutions at or before the end of the next five year update cycle.
