

**ORDINANCE NO. 2-2026**

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AND ENACTING A NEW CODE FOR THE TOWN OF MOORCROFT, WYOMING; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES NOT INCLUDED THEREIN; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; PROVIDING FOR THE MANNER OF AMENDING SUCH CODE**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF MOORCROFT, WYOMING:**

Section 1. The Code entitled "Code of the Town of Moorcroft, Wyoming " published by CivicPlus, LLC is adopted.

Section 2. All ordinances of a general and permanent nature enacted on or before June 11, 2025, and not included in the Code or recognized and continued in force by reference therein, are repealed.

Section 3. The repeal provided for in section 2 hereof shall not be construed to revive any ordinance or part thereof that has been repealed by a subsequent ordinance that is repealed by this ordinance.

Section 4. Additions or amendments to the Code when passed in such form as to indicate the intention to make the same a part of the Code shall be deemed to be incorporated in the Code, so that reference to the Code includes the additions and amendments.

Section 5. Nothing in the Code or this ordinance shall affect any offense or act committed or done or any penalty or forfeiture incurred or any contract or right established or accruing before the effective date of this Code. The adoption of the Code shall not be interpreted as authorizing or permitting any use or the continuance of any use of a structure or premises in violation of any ordinance or resolution in effect on the date of adoption of this Code.

Section 6. The provisions of the Code, insofar as they are substantially the same as legislation previously adopted by the town relating to the same subject matter, shall be construed as restatement and continuation thereof and not as new enactments.

Section 7. Nothing in this ordinance or the Code shall be construed to repeal or otherwise affect the validity of any of the following:

- (1) Administrative ordinances of the town not in conflict or inconsistent with the provisions of this Code.
- (2) Any appropriation or budget ordinance.

- (3) Any ordinance promising or guaranteeing the payment of money for the town or authorizing the issuance of any bonds of the town or any evidence of the town's indebtedness.
- (4) Any contract, agreement, or obligation assumed by the town.
- (5) Any ordinance or resolution establishing or fixing the salaries, retirement and pension plans, benefits, personnel policies, and/or administrative procedures for town officers or employees not otherwise enumerated in this Code.
- (6) Any right or franchise granted by the town
- (7) Any ordinance providing for local improvements and assessing taxes therefor.
- (8) Any ordinance dedicating, naming, establishing, locating, relocating, opening, widening, paving, etc., any street or public way.
- (9) Any ordinance establishing or prescribing street grades.
- (10) Any ordinance dedicating or accepting any subdivision plat.
- (11) Any ordinance levying or imposing or otherwise pertaining to taxes not included in this Code.
- (12) Any other ordinance or resolution, or part thereof, which is not of a general and permanent nature; or which is referred to in the Code as continuing in effect.
- (13) Any ordinance that is temporary, although general in effect;
- (14) Any ordinance that is special, although permanent in effect; or
- (15) Any ordinance the purpose of which has been accomplished.

Section 8. Ordinances adopted after the date specified in section 2 hereof that amend or refer to ordinances that have been codified in the Code shall be construed as if they amend or refer to like provisions of the Code.


